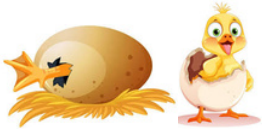

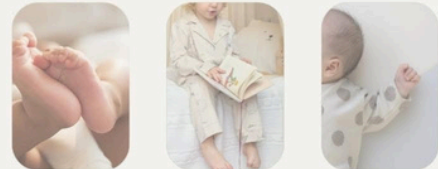

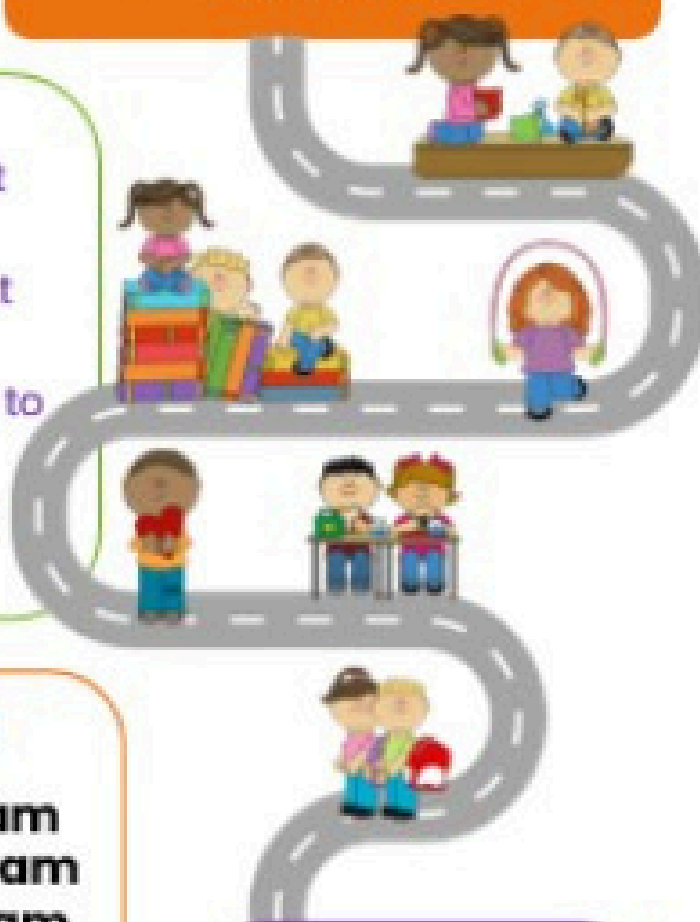


Two and Beyond Your child's learning journey

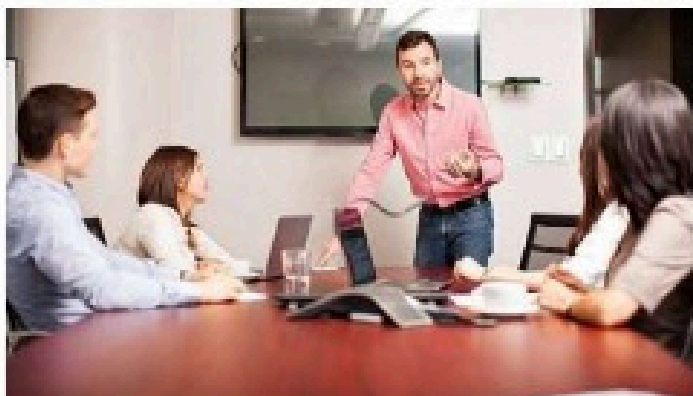

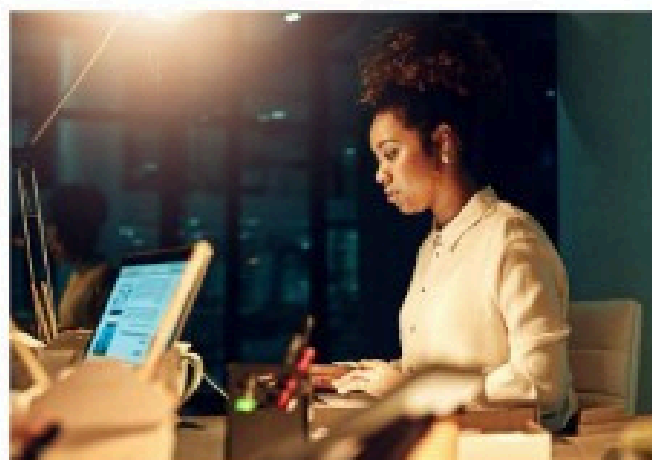
